Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time & Transfiguration of the Lord:

In our Gospel reading, Jesus points us in a certain direction by giving us two short parables to think about-the treasure hidden in the field and the pearl of great value.

In both of these parables, Jesus is telling us that

we need to be centering our life around one thing and one thing only-the Kingdom of God. Selling everything you have so that you can buy that treasure, so that you can have that pearl?

It's seeing all other men and women as coming from God, and as being our sisters and brothers. The Kingdom of God is all around us and within us. We need the eves of faith to recognize it, and to live in this Kingdom with respect and love for it's Creator, and for all that has come from the hands of this Creator.


